TODDLER

PRE-K

Our Pre-K classrooms are multi-sensory learning playgrounds for your future Kindergartener! We provide the foundation for success for the rest of your child's academic career. Our curriculum incorporates a theme-based and The Creative Curriculum. Through a theme-based approach, children learn to make connections constantly, thereby developing a much deeper and broader level of understanding than traditional learning can compete with.

Critical thinking skills are much more developed, because students regularly explore ideas, compare and evaluate viewpoints, apply knowledge, and even create new ideas.

In turn, this leads to advanced creative thinking (thinking outside the box) and problem-solving skills.

We provide your child with an engaged and inspired learning environment that encourages development, curiosity, and builds confidence. As your child prepares to take on the world, it is our goal to have them socially, emotionally, academically, and physically ready for their next adventure!

Kindergarten

Kindergarten is a time for young children to build on their natural curiosity about the world around them, socialize with their peers in large and small groups, explore carefully organized learning centers, and develop foundational skills in age and stage appropriate ways. Kindergarten is an introduction to formal schooling for young children; and it is important that the classroom environment, schedule and experiences are based on developmentally appropriate practices, research-based curricula and culturally relevant materials. This guidance document will focus on the use of centers in kindergarten.

Kindergarten students learn through interacting and engaging with their peers and teachers in learning centers, through open ended activities, and hands-on experiences with a wide variety of materials.

Before and After School

Before school care is available on school days for some Public Schools. Before school care opens at 7:00 am. Children have the opportunity to eat breakfast at GLA.

After school it is a carefully planned flexible program in a supervised environment that allows children to play, make decisions, develop leadership skills, as well as to participate in more structured activities according to their interest.

Students attend the program from school dismissal to 6:00pm. An option for full-day care on most days when school is closed is offered. GLA provides care on early dismissal days.

Upon arrival from the regular school day, the children are given a transition time. At this time, they can meet their own personal needs, enjoy snacks, relax, gather for leisure talk with friends, and receive orientation for the day's activities. Activities may include supervised, playground play, arts, crafts, music, drama, board games, computers, etc. Time is provided for individualized help with homework. Snacks are provided daily.

Preschool

In our preschool program your child will flourish in an environment filled with child-initiated activities that balance play and discovery by teacher direction and instruction

Our teachers have years of experience and are able to help maximize your child's potential wonderfully while nurturing their unique personality. We learn language, pre-reading, math, science, Spanish, cultural studies and art in our preschool classrooms. We integrate a lot of fun, laughs and music into our everyday learning.

The focus is on developing your preschoolers cognitive, sensory, motor and language skills. Your preschooler is gently encouraged to gain independence and develop a sense of self-awareness in a loving environment.
